



DRESS RULES - MEN

NOT Acceptable

Trousers and Shorts: Must be tailored. Shorts shall be worn with a belt and are to be worn with predominantly white long or short golf socks. All denim and jeans of any colour or bearing brand names, leisure suits or tracksuits not permitted.

Shirts: All shirts must have collars and be worn tucked into trousers.

Shoes and Socks: Long or short golf socks may be worn with tailored shorts. Golf socks MUST be worn above the ankle, no ankle socks permitted. Regulation Golf shoes (soft spikes) must be worn on the course. Sandals, jogging shoes and tennis shoes not permitted.
